Since its launch this year at Sanctuary Cove International Boat Show there has been a flurry of interest; clientele within the large yacht arena have wanted to put it through its paces on the water. With a price tag of close to 20 million dollars, it is a yacht in a class of its own. The vision of Jack Mackeddie from Mackeddie Marine to create a yacht that could travel long distances in pure luxury, with an efficient fuel capacity, is a reality. Platinum is a yacht that would suit charter guests and owners equally, with accommodation to sleep ten people very comfortably. The outdoor spaces compliment the desires of guests wanting to enjoy the fresh air and teak decks. With

three levels of space to spread out you have the option to enjoy seclusion or join the other guests on the deck for a meal, dinner, drinks and Jacuzzi.

Walking onboard, expectations of a fabulous week-long trip cruising through some of the most magnificent waters in the world will be set. Platinum is available for sale or charter throughout Australia. The capacity of this yacht to cruise long distances, with minimal effort, is a bonus when it comes to getting to those out of the way destinations. With a range of 4500 nautical miles and ability to hold 9000 litres of water, the scope of adventures is endless including trans-Pacific and global ranges.

The cabin deck boasts four double cabins all with their own ensuite; their entry is via

a spacious hallway. Each cabin is very large with walk-around queen size beds, double wardrobes and portholes to take advantage of the natural light. This area allows guests to get away and enjoy their own personal retreat in the evenings; all the amenities of a luxurious hotel room are included. The master cabin is located on the first level, occupying a large area in the forward port section and creating a unique private space. The master is designed for the owner or guest, who is familiar with the finer things in life.

The finish throughout is a combination of European Beech, Tasmanian Myrtle and oak which all compliment each other and the ambience aboard. The décor is consistent with the accented highlights of fabrics and


luxurious woods crafted with precision. The amalgamation of the three internal levels works well with an individual staircase that leads down to the guest accommodation and a showpiece staircase that takes you to the sky lounge and bridge from the first level. The living spaces are non-cluttered and have prominent furniture pieces custom made to work in with the layout that is conducive to relaxing in comfort. The dining table on the first level can accommodate all ten guests – after pre-dinner drinks at the bar upstairs, this is a spectacular way to end another day wherever the yacht may be anchored or moored.

This feeling of luxury carries through to the aft decks that are encircled with seating on every level. On the first deck, a large Huon Pine and Myrtle teak table is smartly divided into two sections allowing easy access to the aft lounge, perfect for dining whilst overlooking the swim platform and the water.

A definitive highlight of MY Platinum is the sundeck that emphasises the al fresco plans of this yacht with a six person raised Jacuzzi, a bar equipped with BBQ, fridge and a large dining table. The sundeck, complete with lounges, is the perfect place to relax with plenty of room. The deck space is large enough to have exercise equipment installed or to conduct private classes. Looking down and forward from the sundeck, the view of the bow of this yacht is spectacular with its unique powerful lines and runway-style

gangplank to the fore deck. It would be hard to remove yourself from this vantage point, especially whilst cruising as the wind and views surround you.

Enjoying this experience of cruising would not be complete without the inclusion of staff to look after all your needs. There are provisions for six crewmembers. The substantial galley, which is the entrance to the crew quarters, is professionally equipped for entertaining and has an abundance of storage space for long voyages. Cruising any distance and manoeuvring this yacht is pure joy for any captain. Everything has been thought of and included on the bridge with the latest electronics, video surveillance and touch screen monitoring systems. Boasting two MTU series 60 engines with a cruising speed of 11 knots and fuel consumption at cruising speed of 80 litres per hour, you are sure to reach your destination on time and in style.

Platinum is a unique opportunity awaiting a possible buyer; enjoy a charter onboard prior to deciding if this is the yacht for you. Platinum is currently based at Sanctuary Cove Queensland Australia and is available for an array of cruising options.
